The recent report that petitions for the annexation of Cuba to the United States have been quietly circulated, receiving the signatures of large numbers of influential Cubans throughout the island, has been followed by a corresponding political flurry in this country likely to produce a crop of congressional debates this winter.

Caroline Graiser has brought suit for a divorce in the Circuit Court against Julius Graiser on the ground of cruel and inhuman treatment. The plaintiff alleges that she was married to the defendant in December, 1899, and that he disregarded his duties as a husband, has for a long time past and since their marriage been guilty of cruel treatment of herself; that the defendant would frequently become angry at her and at such times would insult her and conduct himself in a rude and unkind manner and would threaten to leave plaintiff, that he neglected and refused to contribute toward her support.

Mamie Jewett has filed a suit for divorce against Amos Jewett. Her attorneys are Graham and Cleeton, of Portland. The couple were married in 1881 at Jackson County, Iowa. The plaintiff alleges that her husband inflicted personal indignities upon her and in 1898 made indecent proposals to Flora, their 12-year-old daughter. She alleges cruel and inhuman treatment and non-support. She also asks to be allowed to resume her maiden name of Minnie Fay.

The executor in the estate of James L. Bailey, deceased, by his attorney, J. W. Loder, asks the court for an order granting permission to sell the personal property, valued at \$19. The court has authorized the sale, and the proceeds will be applied in the interests of the estate.

TAMMANY LOSES IN NEW YORK

Low's Plurality Over Shepherd About 40,000.

QUAY WINS IN PENNSYLVANIA

Republicans Have Increased Plurality in Ohio and Over 10,000 Majority in Nebraska.

Seth Low was elected Mayor of New York by from 30,000 to 40,000 plurality. Jerome, for District Attorney, has a comfortable majority, and Mayor Van Wyck, for Supreme Court Justice, was defeated.

The Republicans carried Ohio by increased pluralities, that of Governor Nash being placed at 60,000. The reelection of Foraker is assured.

In Pennsylvania the Republican ticket was elected by smaller pluralities than in 1899. Hothermel, the Union-Anti-Quay candidate for District Attorney at Philadelphia, was beaten by 43,678 plurality.

The figures from Maryland are incomplete, but indicate Democratic control of the Legislature. The vote in Baltimore is very close, and whichever party wins will not have over 3000 majority.

Democrats will have an increased majority in the Kentucky Legislature. They also elected the Mayor of Louisville. In Rhode Island the plurality of the Republican state ticket will run over 8000.

W. Murray Crane was for the third time elected Governor of Massachusetts. The State Legislature will be strongly Republican.

In Connecticut the Republicans elected a majority of the delegates to the constitutional convention.

Arapahoe County, Colorado, is Democratic, but Republicans were successful at Pueblo, Colorado Springs, and Leadville.

Cummins, the Republican candidate for Governor of Iowa, was elected by a plurality of about 90,000.

The Republican ticket in Nebraska was elected by 10,000 majority.

South Dakota Republicans claim to have elected the eight Circuit Judges.

The entire Republican ticket was elected in Salt Lake, and probably in most of the other Utah cities.

Republicans were generally successful in the local elections in Kansas.

In New Jersey, Murphy, Republican, is elected Governor by about 10,000 plurality. Both branches of the Legislature will be Republican.

The Democratic state ticket in Virginia was elected by at least 25,000 majority.
