Master Fish Warden H. G. VanDusen was in the city Friday. He is making preparations to commence work at Upper Clackamas Hatchery Station.

Ontario is an ideal place for a hatchery. It is from 75 to 100 miles below the Falls and 50 miles above Hood River.

The plan of Warden VanDusen is to throw a lead across the main channel of the foot of the island and the fish naturally be diverted into the side channel on the Oregon side.

Warden VanDusen left Friday afternoon for Warren's cannery on the Columbia where he will inspect wing dams in operation there.
