For Office Again. "I am out of politics and I intend to stay out," said State Senator Brownell, this morning.

"Do you really mean to say that you are entirely out of politics, and for good?" queried the reporter, who had heard the statement before, but not from so direct a source.

"Most emphatically my answer to that is yes," was the senator's reply. "Of course, I shall be pleased to help my friends, if they need my help, and at all times do what I can to bring about the election of the Republican ticket. I am through asking for office, and have done with taking any general or active part in party politics. I make this statement, as I think it is due my many friends in Clackamas county. What I want now is law business," and with the

last declaration Mr. Brownell gave his attention to a client who had been waiting for the interview to terminate.

COUNTY HAS A SHOW. Can Make a Defense Against Lumbermen's Claim.

District Attorney Allen has filed a motion in the circuit court to open up the judgment in the case of Alfred Bluffing, ex-county recorder, who recently secured judgment by default against the county for \$1400 and accrued interest amounting to the same, to about \$1900.

After hearing a motion in the case, Judge McBride, on Tuesday afternoon, ordered the judgment in the case opened up and the case is now at issue.

Dist. Atty. Allen was permitted to file a motion to strike out parts of the complaint. Since the presiding judge and the entire list of jurors are interested parties, inasmuch as they are taxpayers in this county, it is probable the case will be heard in Multnomah county.

The action is the outgrowth of a dispute between the ex-county recorder and the county commissioners court as to the payment of claims for deputy hire. Under the law by which these deputies were employed, it was optional with the county court as to whether or not the deputies employed by the recorder should be paid by the county and also what wages they should be paid.

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
