The Servant's Question. Mrs. Newly Wed (from above)—Bridget, put the lemon on the ice so they won't get sour.

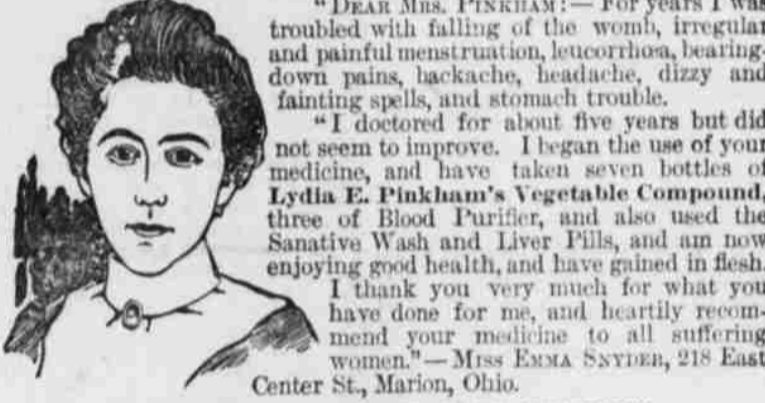
Not the Same. Tess—He said I looked handsome in that gown, didn't he? Jess—Not exactly. He said that gown looked handsome on you.—Exchange.
