> PURE CITY WATER.-The beauty of the operation of the filtering system employed at the Oregon City water works was demonstrated last week during the heavy rain storms. In spite of the badly discolored state of the water in the river, after passing through the filtering system the water drawn from either hy-drant or faucet was perfectly clear and as nearly pure as a public water service can turnish. In the operation of the system the water is first conveyed from the river into two tanks of 40,000 gallons capacity each. The water is thence carried to the filter tank, where it passes through about four feet of sand and filtering screens, in course of which all sediment and impurities are removed, and is emptied into a cistern having a capacity of 65,000 gallons. For a complete ity water system, Superintendent Howell thinks Oregon City's plant is not equalled in the state, and his conclusion finds confirmation in the faultless condition of the city water during the entire year.
