Republican State Convention.

Notice is hereby given that the Republican state convention of the Republican party of the state of Oregon is hereby called to meet in the city of Portland, Oregon, on Thursday, April 14, 1904...

Call for Congressional Convention. A convention of the Republican party of the first congressional district of the state of Oregon is hereby called to meet in Salem, Ore., Wednesday, April 13, at 11 a. m., for the purpose of nominating one representative for congress and to transact such other business as may properly come before the convention.

The convention will consist of 177 delegates, apportioned among the several counties of the district as follows, to-wit: Benton, 7; Clackamas, 18; Coos, 9; Curry, 3; Douglas, 14; Jackson, 12; Josephine, 7; Klamath, 4; Lake, 4; Lane, 19; Lincoln, 5; Linn, 14; Marion, 23; Polk, 9; Tillamook, 5; Washington, 13; Yamhill, 11; total, 177.

Delegates or others in attendance at the convention may secure a rate of one and one-third fares for the round trip on the Southern Pacific and the Corvallis & Eastern railways by paying full fare to Salem, taking a receipt for fare paid from the ticket agent and having same properly certified by the secretary of the convention.

List of Corporation Taxes for the Year 1903, Clackamas County, Oregon.

\$10,000.00 worth of machinery was sold out of station "A" by the Willamette Pulp & Paper Co. in 1903 and \$5,000.00 was deducted from their assessment to compensate for this.

The O. W. P. & Ry. Co. was raised from \$1,400.00 per mile to \$3,500.00 per mile and the material on hand for the construction of the line up the Clackamas assessed for \$20,000.00.

The Weyerhaeuser Timber Co. and T. D. & E. S. Collins pay on over 31,000 acres of timber land that was assessed in 1902 for \$1.25 per acre, and for the same land they are now assessed for \$5.00 per acre, nearly five times the assessment of 1902.

The expense of running the assessor's office for the year 1901, for salaries alone, amounted to \$4,950.00. This was the year in which field deputies were sent out, but does not include the cost of the present owner maps, which were a separate expense.

Repeated assertions by the "Courier" that doubling the assessment raised the taxes can be disproved by reading the new law governing the state tax which is as follows: "In order to ascertain the amount of taxes to be paid (to the state) by the several counties, state officers shall ascertain from the report of the EXPENDITURES of the several counties, on file in the office of the secretary of state, the average amount of expenditure in each county for a period of five years; and each county shall pay such proportion of said state tax as its average amount of expenditures for said period bears to the total amount of expenditures in all of the counties of the state."

The only difference in doubling the assessment of the county, is that the levy is 20 1/2 mills instead of 41 mills.

OUR FIRST REPUBLIC.

It was Not the United States, but the Louisiana Republic. The first republic in this hemisphere to succeed in compelling recognition of its independence was, of course, the Republic whose proud capital is Washington.

When France, in 1794, ceded Louisiana to Spain, the subjects of King Louis XV, objected to the transfer without their consent. The local government submitted the question to the council, which, under the lead of Nicholas Chauvin de Lafreniere, rose in revolt.

It was then that the people of Louisiana resolved on a radical course. On the night of Oct. 28, 1793, the rebels took possession of the French forts and the gates of the town in the name of the republic of Louisiana.
