It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firm or corporation within the corporate limits of Oregon City to expose for sale, sell or offer for sale, barter, exchange, give or offer to sell, barter, exchange or give, or cause to be sold, bartered, exchanged or given, to or with any person, any fire-cracker over three inches in length, any bomb, dynamite cane. Dewey-chaser, torpedoes, toy pistols or other detonating works of simflar character.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to have in his possession, expose, use, discharge or explode any fire-cracker more than three inches in length, any bomb, dynamite cane, Dewey-chaser, torpedoes, toy pistol or other detonating Charman & Co., City Drug Store. works of similar character, within the corporate limits of Oregon City.

Section 3. Anyone who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance tlement thereof. shall, upon conviction before the Mayor or Recorder of Oregon City, be subjected Administratrix of the estate of Edward to a fine of not less than Five Dollars or more than One Hundred Dollars, or by imprisonment in the City jall not to exceed fifty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment; however no provision of this Ordinance shall be construed so as to restrain the lawful sale and use of explosives for improvement purposes


