U. S. Department of Agriculture Issues Some Statistics.
The following data, covering a period of 34 years, have been compiled from the Weather Bureau Records at Portland, Oregon. They are issued to show the conditions that have prevailed during the month in question for the above period of years, but must not be construed as a forecast of the weather conditions for the coming month.
Month, June, for 34 years.
TEMPERATURE.
Mean or normal temperature, 62 degrees.
The warmest month was that of 1899, with an average of 66 degrees.
The coldest month was that of 1893 with an average of 58 degrees.
The highest temperature was 99 degrees on June 17, 1876 and June 29, 1904.
The lowest temperature was 39 degrees on June 4, 1875 and June 6, 1899.
The earliest date on which first killing frost occurred in autumn, October 13.
Average date on which first killing frost occurred in autumn, November 15th.
Average date on which last killing frost occurred in spring, March 17th.
The latest date on which last killing frost occurred in spring, May 9th.
PRECIPITATION.
Average for the month 1.70 inches.
Average number of days with .01 of an inch or more, 11.
The reatest monthly precipitation was 5.28 inches in 1888.
The least monthly precipitation was 0.68 inches in 1883.
The greatest amount of precipitation recorded in any 24 hours was 1.85 inches on June 17, 1873.

The prevailing winds have been from the Northwest.
