#### DEMISE OF AGED MOLALLA RESIDENT

Goorge H. Gregory, Sr., Succumbs to Attack of Pneumonia- Funeral on Saturday.

The funeral of George H. Gregory, Sr., who died of pneumonia at the home of his son George H. Gregory, Jr., at Molalla, was held Saturday morning at 10 o'clock from the house. Interment took place in Mountain View cemetery, the Rev. Spies, officiating.

Mr. Gregory, who was 80 years old, was born in Somersetshire, England, Portland, Oregon. in 1827, and came to this country in 1869. He lived in New York state, where he was a large property owner and teasle grower, until the spring of 1904. Three sons and four daughters survive of whom George H. Gregory, Jr., of Molalia, and S. E. Gregory of Carus, reside in Clackamas county.
