Among the new incorporations given out from the office of the secretary of state at Salem, Saturday, was the following:

The Star Press, principal office, Oregon City, Or.; capital stock \$20,000; incorporators, H. A. Galloway, Sara H. Galloway, Snow V. Heaton and E. C. Thomas.

The organization of the printing and publishing company to be known as the Star Press, has been completed by the election of a board of directors, who have selected H. A. Galloway as president, and Snow V. Heaton as secretary.

The four incorporators named in the Salem dispatch are the sole owners of the capital stock of The Star Press. Mr. Galloway is the present publisher of the Daily Star and has been for the last four months lessee and manager of the Oregon City Enterprise.

The Daily Star has been sold by Mr. Galloway to The Star Press, which will hereafter publish the paper in the Enterprise office as heretofore, and Mr. Galloway will continue editor and manager.

"First of all the news" will continue to be the aim and ideal of the Daily Star, and Oregon City and Clackamas county news first of all the news, so Star readers need not expect any radical changes of policy.

The liberal patronage enjoyed by the Daily Star has caused the whole state to "wake-up" to the fact that this is one of the best as well as one of the oldest towns in the state.

That 1907 may be the biggest and best year in Oregon City's history and that every reader of the Star may have a generous slice of the prosperity is the Daily Star's earnest wish.

The Star Press has also bought the Oregon City Enterprise newspaper, business, good will and plant of L. L. Porter, together with the Enterprise job plant, for a consideration of \$10,000 cash.

The Enterprise job plant, with possibly one exception at Salem, is now the best equipped of any in the state outside of Portland, and capable of turning out all classes of work.

OREGON'S FIRST WOMAN PHYSICIAN

Dr. Owens-Adair Visits Oregon City-her Interesting Life's History

Dr. Owens-Adair, the publication of whose life history has received so much favorable comment from the Oregon papers, was in the city, Monday, a guest of Mrs. Eva Emery Dye.

There is hardly a person in Oregon who has not heard of the plucky woman who crossed the plains with her parents in 1843, was married and a mother at fourteen, and who at eighteen began to learn to read and write in the primary classes of the public schools along with her little brothers and sisters.

In a few years she was a popular teacher herself, and such was her thirst for knowledge that by her own and unaided exertions she saved up money enough to go east where at Ann Arbor she took a thorough course in medicine and came back to practice, the first woman physician in Oregon.

A natural financier, and skilled with the best in her profession, in a few years. Dr. Owens-Adair had \$50,000 in her own right, and probably no other woman in Oregon has been intimate with so many notable governors, senators and historic characters of the last fifty years of Oregon history.
