Be it remembered, that at a regular term of the County Court of Clackamas County, held in the Court House in Oregon City...

In the matter of the improvement of road known as Outy and Stevens road; Ordered that petition and subscription of \$200 be duplicated by county court.

In the matter of fencing and obstructing a county road by one John Teevin in road district No. 3; Ordered that John Teevin be cited to appear before the county court...

In the matter of the petition of John C. Jacobson and others for a county road; Ordered that viewers meet at place of beginning of said road on the 15th day of March, 1907.

In the matter of the petition of J. C. Elliott and others for a county road; Ordered that viewers meet at place of beginning of said road on the 15th day of March, 1907.

In the matter of application of road district for 20,000 feet of lumber to repair Hood View road; Ordered that 20,000 feet of lumber be purchased and delivered on said road at price not to exceed \$5.00 per thousand.

In the matter of fencing and obstructing a county high road by Fred Holzman; Ordered that Fred Holzman immediately remove all fencing placed in road by himself and that the supervisor of district No. 17 see that this order is complied with.

In the matter of petition of William Thompson for return of tax money due him from county; Ordered that \$34.34 be returned to him for tax paid twice in year 1903.

In the matter of application of J. M. B. Sellwood and T. R. A. Sellwood for record of plat of Quincy addition to Millwaukie; Ordered that same be and is approved and ordered recorded.

In the matter of the petition of Franz Kraxberger for improvement of road leading from Aurora to the Canby and Maxberger road and subscription of \$146.00; Ordered that petition be granted and that county appropriate an equal amount.

In the matter of report of viewers on the Gibson road; Ordered that papers be submitted to district attorney for opinion.

In the matter of the lines of the Oregon Water Power & Railway company's rendering a road crossing dangerous; Ordered that the clerk immediately notify said company to repair said crossing and make same safe for travel.

In the matter of the application for plank to repair county road in district 20 south of Clark's Post office; Ordered that \$100 be appropriated out of road fund for said repairs.

In the matter of resignation of James Pegles as supervisor of district 7; Ordered that said resignation be accepted and that F. E. McGugin be and is appointed as supervisor of said road district No. 7.

In the matter of the application of the Oregon Electric Railway Co. for permission to cross county roads near Wilsonville; Ordered that permission be granted for said crossing subject to proper regulations by court.

In the matter of deed from Chas. F. Clark and wife to land for public road in district No. 2; Ordered that deed for said roadway be accepted and recorded by Clackamas county, and that improvements on said road be made at the expense of those benefitted thereby and not from road fund of district No. 2.

In the matter of the Wettlaufer road; Ordered that said road be and is declared to be a county road.

In the matter of claim for damages by Fred Scheruble for damages by location of Wettlaufer road; Ordered that said claim be and is denied.

In the matter of the petition of the Weyerhaeuser Land company for rebate of tax; Ordered that petition be granted and that a warrant be drawn on treasurer for \$37.25 in favor of petitioner.

In the matter of petition of Mrs. Crutcher for rebate of tax; Ordered that warrant be drawn in favor of petitioner for \$11.48. (To be continued Wednesday.)
