BAD RUNAWAY ACCIDENT.

Mrs. Scanlon, of Beaver Creek, Sustains Serious Injury. Mrs. William Scanlon, of Beaver Creek, was the victim of a runaway accident Monday. While driving into town with her son, Elmer Loneragan, the team took fright at a passing train, and ran down Singer Hill, bringing up against the bank at the foot of the hill at the Tenth street crossing, overturning the buggy and throwing the occupants out. Loneragan escaped without injury, but Mrs. Scanlon sustained the fracture of her right arm and had several ribs broken, and was cut severely about the head. She was taken to the home of George A. Harding and a physician called, and she was later removed to the Electric hotel, where she will have to stay for several days before she can be taken home. Mrs. Scanlon is past 50 years of age, and notwithstanding her injuries, she had a remarkable escape from being killed.
