DON'T BLOCK THE WHEELS.

Much comment, mainly unfavorable, is heard over the action of the Crown-Columbia Pulp & Paper Company in seeking to obstruct the work of construction by the Hawley Pulp & Paper Company in this city. The temporary injunction will hardly be made permanent, and were there no legal problems involved its dissolution would be speedy, for there is nothing in years that promises so much for the benefit of Oregon City as the coming of the Hawley mill. The concern will not only provide employment for several hundred men, and will bring at least 50 families into Oregon City, but it will pay a city tax that will be no trifling, and should be carefully considered in view of the distressing financial condition of the city.

Mr. Hawley is essentially a man of foresight and business sagacity and it is not to be assumed that he has gone blindly to work without knowing his legal rights and preparing to see that they are protected to the letter. He is spending hundreds of thousands of dollars in Oregon City and will spend millions among the laboring people in years to come, and this money will find its way into the channels of business.

EDUCATION AND PROGRESS.

Education is the key note of public progress. The ignorant people of some of the Oriental and Latin countries have been standing still for hundreds and thousands of years. Neglect of study has dulled their minds. Here and there a country has awakened, like Japan, and whenever the awakening has occurred, it has been preceded by the education of its people.

Clackamas County can well take some lessons along this line. Not that the people are ignorant, for they are not. They are probably above the average class of Americans. But in many places, notably Oregon City, they have been willing to stop at a common school education for their children. It was a trite saying of Dr. W. E. Carrl at the graduation exercises in this city Tuesday night that some of us pay less attention to the boy next door than we do to the neighbor's cow.

It is with joy and delight, then, that we rejoice at the action of the people of this city in instructing their board of directors to install a complete high school course in the public schools. Oregon City has long been behind her little neighbors in this respect, and her educational unprogressiveness has been a source of constant annoyance to men and women who have been striving earnestly to establish a high school here. The members of the Barelay Alumni Association, Mr. C. Schuebel, Miss Laura Beatle, Mr. Clarence Eaton and other leaders are to be congratulated upon their success in at last bringing about a condition that will permit the children of this city to obtain a high school education at home.

Swinging into line, we have Willamette and the new district of Gladstone including the ninth and tenth grades in their course of study. We look with some amazement upon the people of Parkplace, who levied a tax of 20 mills and subscribed money to support a high school. This is the proper spirit and is worthy of commendation.

The movement for the organization of a Commercial Club seems to be lagging. The start was brave, but how about the finish. Some contention exists relative to the advisability of operating a buffet in connection with the club, and there is determined opposition.
