COST OF CONDUCTING AFFAIRS OF COUNTY DURING LAST SIX MONTHS.

BIG ELECTION EXPENSE

Roads and Bridges Are Principal Item—Net Indebtedness of Clackamas County Is \$111,392.29.

The cost of operating the affairs of Clackamas County for the six months ending September 30 was \$100,728.72. This information is embraced in the semi-annual report of County Clerk Greenman. The general expense was \$27,699.11, the largest item being \$15,122.83 for elections, which will not be included in the expense next year. Roads and bridges during the half-year cost Clackamas County \$75,496.61. The general expenses of the county are apportioned as follows: County court and commission \$1,004.90; Circuit Court \$268.15; Justice Court \$61.15; Sheriff \$325.23; Clerk \$1,577.49; Recorder \$1,786.82; Treasurer \$691.98; Coroner \$199.45; Superintendent of Schools \$46.83; Assessor \$331.67; Tax Department \$463.38; Tax rebates \$227.77; Current expense \$455.56; Courthouse expense \$150.42; Jail \$65.37; County poor \$219.48; Indigent soldier \$78.00; Insane \$17.14; Elections \$512.98; Printing and advertising \$1,295.83; Damages \$190.00; Surveys \$106.55; Board of Health \$234.15; Fruit Inspector \$63.00; During the six months Sheriff Heale collected \$28,672.31 in taxes. The net indebtedness of the county as shown by the treasurer's report is \$111,392.29.
