ESTATE LEFT TO MOONEY. Michael Sheehan, Deceased, Makes Will and Files it in July. The estate of Michael Sheehan, who was found dead in his home near the Rock Creek Bridge on Thursday afternoon, was probated Friday. The property is valued at \$1500. A will was made and filed by the deceased in July, 1904, in which he bequeathes his money in the bank and all property to Thomas Francis Mooney, of Clackamas, Oregon, and Mooney's father, Thomas Mooney, of the same place is named as executor without bonds. Sheehan was a bachelor and has resided near Clackamas for the past 14 years, being a friend of the Mooney family for some time. His body was found at 2 o'clock Thursday afternoon. He had been dead but a short time when found. The deceased was about 60 years of age. The funeral was held from the St. John Catholic church Saturday morning, Father Hillebrand officiating. The interment was in the Catholic cemetery.
