We respectfully submit for your consideration the following report of matters in connection with the business of the district transacted during the fiscal year just ended.

This year we have installed new furniture in the Eastham building at a cost of \$1975.00 and we have had constructed the Eastham building a four-room addition in order to provide accommodations for the rapidly increasing number of pupils.

The establishment of a complete four-grade high school has necessitated the employment of two additional teachers and it is possible that another high school instructor may be employed in the attendance demands of the high school.

During the summer vacation last year the Barclay building was repainted at a cost of \$478.00.

The financial condition of the district and the receipts and disbursements for the fiscal year are shown by the annual report of the district clerk, which is hereto appended.
