District No. 62 School Report.
Oregon City, Or., June 20, 1910.
To the taxpayers and patrons of School District No. 62, Clackamas County, Oregon:
We respectfully submit for your consideration the following report of the fiscal year just ended. The financial condition of the district is excellent, as we have no floating debt, and have a cash balance of \$1,587.40, exclusive of a sinking fund of \$2,900 for the purpose of repayment of bonds as they become due, as is required by law.
The growth of the city schools and the desirability of keeping pace with other Oregon cities in matters educational caused us to recommend the construction of a high school building, and we were recently authorized by the taxpayers to issue bonds to the amount of \$40,000 for the purchase of a site and the construction and equipment of a suitable building. These bonds will be sold at once, and it is expected that soon after the opening of the Fall term this year, the building will be ready for occupancy. It will be of substantial construction and modern in every respect and will be a credit to Oregon City.
There are now 22 teachers in the corps. Owing to the increased cost of living, salaries have been advanced; the minimum for the coming school year will be \$5 and the maximum \$75 for teachers. The salary of the city superintendent has been increased to \$1,600 and that of the principal of the Barclay building to \$100 per month. It is the object of the Board of Directors, however, to keep the expenses of operation within the estimates.
In order to provide room for the pupils \$15.50 was expended in completing the addition to the Eastham building. Two classrooms have been maintained during the year in the Barclay gymnasium building.
The general scholastic condition of the schools of Oregon City is very satisfactory to the Directors. Laboratory apparatus has been secured during the year and installed in the high school. It is the purpose of the Board to establish departments in domestic science, manual training and drawing as soon as the new high school building is completed.
The financial condition of the district and the receipts and disbursements for the fiscal year are shown by the annual report of the district clerk, which is hereto appended.
