FUNERAL TO BE IN REDLAND CHURCH Aged Man Nursed by Nephew, His Only Relative in Oregon--Lived on Farm He Settled.

J. C. Bates, 80 years of age, one of the best known men in Clackamas county, died of pneumonia Wednesday morning.

Mr. Bates had lived at Redland since 1872 on a farm which he settled. He frequently visited Portland and Oregon City and had friends in all parts of the state.

When he was stricken, Dr. E. E. Chase, a nephew of Mr. Bates and the only relative he had in Oregon, left his home in Silverton and has been in constant attendance upon his uncle.

Mr. Bates came west when a young man and, after looking around some time, decided to settle in Oregon. He was prominently identified with the history of Clackamas county and was beloved by all who knew him.

The funeral will be held at 11 o'clock Friday at the Methodist church in Redland, and the interment will be in the Redland cemetery.






