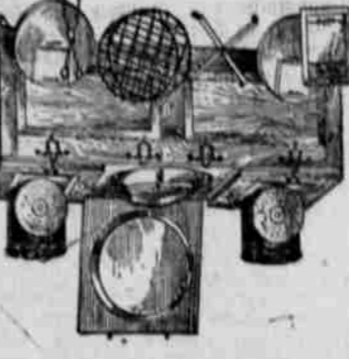

PORTLAND TAX ROLL TO BE \$290,000,000

PORTLAND, Aug. 8.—This city will have an assessed valuation of property of approximately \$290,000,000 when County Assessor Sigler completes his assessments for this year, according to conservative estimates. This means that the total increase in valuation of the assessment this year over that of last year will approximate \$15,000,000. This will yield additional taxes of approximately \$230,000. County Assessor Sigler has increased the assessed valuation of practically all the real property between Fourth and Fifth streets west through the new uptown shopping districts and from Burnside street south to Harrison.

Upper Alder street is the pivotal point from which the increase is made. On this thoroughfare the increase is 10 per cent from Fifth street west to its intersection of Washington street. On all other parallel streets from Burnside to Harrison the increases are gradually lessened to about 2 per cent. The reason assigned for levying the greatest increase on the real estate on Alder street is due to the rapid strides this thoroughfare has made as a business district. As an example of the increase in the assessed valuation, the quarter block occupied by the Yeon building last year it has been increased to \$269,000. The quarter block directly west across Fifth street, on which the Lipman & Wolfe department store is being erected, last year was assessed for \$255,000, while this year it has been assessed for \$270,000, or an increase of \$15,000. The southeast corner of Sixth and Alder, occupied by Meier & Frank, last year was assessed for \$230,000, while this year it has been increased to \$250,000. The selling block has been increased from \$258,000 to \$270,000. Like increases have been made in other property in this vicinity. The quarter block at the southeast corner of Fourteenth and Alder last year it is assessed for \$42,000. The quarter block on the southwest corner of Seventeenth and Alder has been increased from \$33,000 to \$36,000. The increases on upper Washington, Morrison and Yamhill are slightly less. The increase on Washington street, however, reaches as far west as Twenty-third street. A considerable advance has been made on the East Side, particularly in Central East Portland. The increases, however, are not so heavy as on the West Side. In residence districts where many improvements have been made during the past year, the assessed valuation has been raised.
