PARTY REACHES TOP OF HIGH MOUNTAIN

Making the ascent of Mount Hood for the tenth time, Raymond Caulfield, with a party, returned to Oregon City at 1 o'clock Monday morning. Caulfield, who is a clerk in the Bank of Oregon City and a former University of Oregon student, said that this would be his last trip up the mountain. He is badly burned about the face from the fierce rays of the sun. Caulfield acted as guide for his party and was accompanied by the mountain by Mortimer Park and Tod Binford, both of Oregon City. The start was made from Government Camp just after midnight Saturday and the summit was reached, after an eight-mile hike, at 2:15 p. m. on Sunday. Mr. Caulfield saw Mount Shasta, 469 miles distant, from the summit of Mount Hood. In addition to the three who climbed the mountain, Percy Caulfield, Fred W. Humphrys and Harry Black, the latter a deputy sheriff of Multnomah county, went from this city by automobile, arriving at Government Camp at 11:30 o'clock Saturday night, but only three members of the party of six made the ascent.

ABSCESS TAKES LIFE OF YOUNG WOMAN

Mrs. Cassie Lawrence, wife of Geo. Lawrence, died early Sunday morning at the Oregon City hospital. Death was due to tubercular abscess. In the judgment of her physicians, she was too weak to stand an operation. Mrs. Lawrence was the daughter of Frank Wilcox, of Redland, where she is well known and where she has lived for a number of years. Japanese growers are in bad in the potato trade and their offerings are almost entirely neglected in the local trade. Fear of "stove piping" is causing the trade in general to give the Japanese growers a wide berth in the local district. American potato growers are experiencing no difficulty in selling their stocks of better quality potatoes at this time, but a different situation is shown when the little brown ones begin to offer. According to one member of the local trade, he would not buy potatoes from Japanese at any price, in fear of getting "stung." While this view is not entirely shared by the produce trade, still there is a feeling that it would be wise to cut the stocks in two before deciding to purchase. With somewhat more free offerings of potatoes, there has been a fractional amount of easiness shown in the local trade recently. No outside demand is noted for local stock because of unimproved quality. Northern business is not coming here as present.
