Arrangements have been made with the railroad lines through this part of the state, both steam and electric, so as to handle the large crowds at special rates," said Mr. M. J. Lee, secretary of the fair association.

"The new poultry barn is one of the most modern buildings of its kind in the northwest, having every feature that could make for better sanitation and light as well as for comfort of the visitors. The building is 24x125 feet and has a large and well-lighted gallery running the entire length.

Exchange Plans - "Another welcome feature will be a private office for poultry breeders, where, it is planned, those interested in the fowls will buy, sell, and exchange. Another department is the enlarging of the swine barn which will now hold many more exhibits.
