



THE session laws of Kansas for 1913 is a book of 594 pages and contains 376 laws and resolutions. The legislature was in session forty-

nine days, consequently something like seven laws passed both houses each day.

It is hardly possible for a member to read SEVEN ENACTMENTS A DAY, and it is an impossibility for him to comprehend and understand them

One of the stock arguments in favor of the bicameral system is that the second chamber is a valuable check on bad legislation because there are two bodies through which the bill must pass. From personal legislative experience I know how FARCICAL this contention is.

I proposed to the Kansas legislature the substitution for the present system of a ONE HOUSE LEGISLATURE, CONSISTING OF NOT TO EXCEED SIXTEEN MEMBERS. One-half of them might be elected from districts and one-halt of them at large, or they might all be nominated by districts and elected at large, with PROVISIONS FOR RECALL AND THE INITIATIVE AND REFERENDUM. These legislators should be elected for TERMS OF FOUR YEARS EACH, with provision for expiration in rotation in order to secure stability and experience.

I further believe that these tegislators should be nominated and elected upon a NONPARTISAN BALLOT.
