P. A. CUPPER PREPARES RURAL CREDITS BILL

ASSISTANT STATE ENGINEER PROPOSES 4 PER CENT STATE BONDS TO RAISE FUND.

SALEM, Ore., Feb. 28.—At the irrigation, drainage and rural credits conference to be held here March 9, there will doubtless be as many bills submitted for consideration as there have been plans suggested for securing the desired results.

I have advocated the issuance of 4 per cent state bonds, the proceeds of which to be loaned direct to the farmer at the same rate of interest and in the same manner as the irrefragable school fund is now loaned.

The simplicity of the plan and the fact that its success has been demonstrated through the loaning of the school fund and the further fact that it does not involve any radical change which would tend to upset our financial system are commendable features.

FISHERMEN OPEN WAR ON GILL ACT IN THE COURTS

ATTEMPT TO OPEN RIVER TO NET FISHING IS BEGUN BY TEST CASE.

MEASURE DECLARED TO CONFLICT WITH CONCURRENT FISHING ACT. Charles Ely Drops Net Into Willamette Above Bridge and is Arrested in Order to Bring Matter into Court.

In an effort to open the river from the suspension bridge to the falls to net fishing, a test case was begun Thursday to knock out the Gill act, passed by the 1915 legislature.
