Minute of Death Is Brought Into Courts. LAW IS CALLED UPON TO DECIDE DELICATE POINT—MUCH LAND AT STAKE.

Melvina Cantonnine, formerly Mrs. Grider, who resided many years in Oregon City, another of Mrs. A. L. Lennon, of this city, has begun suit to quiet title to 1109 acres of land near Cannon, Gilliam county, valued at \$30,000, which she inherited from her son, Wayne Grider.

It will be remembered that last June Wayne Grider, in a fit of jealousy, shot his wife four times with a revolver, and having emptied the same, went out to the woodshed, placed the revolver in a table drawer and returning to the scene of the tragedy with his rifle, stood in front of his wife's prostrate form and fired a bullet up through his own head.

Two doctors who examined the wounds say that in each case death was instantaneous and that Wayne must have survived his wife by at least several minutes.
