

ANY OLD ARGUMENT SUITS THEM
Paid Petition Mongers Are Taken Care of
By Portland Single-tax Newspaper

The following from the Portland Journal seems to be presented as an argument favoring the submission of an individual special tax hobby and for support of it by the voters.
The 1917 Legislature rejected a bill which contained provisions similar to the measure which is to be on the ballot. An Oregon Legislature rejected a local bill, and the people at the next election passed it.
The Oregon Legislature rejected a Corrupt Practices bill, and the people at the next election passed it.
An Oregon Legislature rejected a corporation tax bill, and the people at the next election passed it under the initiative by a vote of nearly ten to one.
The people can get reforms in spite of the Legislature if they determine to do so. They can get this delinquent advertising reform which a Legislature rejected, if they will vote for it at the coming election."
There was another "reform" which was once uppermost in the Journal's weird conception, says the Oregonian. It had something or other to do with public wharves and waterfront. The Legislature rejected it, so the reform was put on the next election ballot at the instance of its newspaper propo-

ent and for the price usually paid to petition hawkers for such services.
It was defeated. It was a reform the people couldn't seem to get "in" spite of the Legislature.
The Legislature has also refused to prohibit compulsory vaccination. Subsequently sustained it.
Conversely the people voted down a sterilization bill and the Legislature passed it.
The people voted down a blue sky law and the Legislature subsequently passed it.
The people voted down a millage tax for certain educational institutions and the Legislature subsequently passed it.
What does it all mean? Merely that in the history of direct legislation you can find an argument for anything—that the people can get reforms in spite of the Legislature; that they can't get reforms in spite of the Legislature, and that they can get reforms in spite of themselves.
But that is all beside the matter of the lovely time we should have if all newspapers, with their superior facilities for publicity, should rush to the petition mongers every time they hatched an idea on how this or that should be done or regulated.

FEDERAL WAR LABOR BOARD TO CONDUCT WAGE SCALE HEARING

PORTLAND, Sept. 24.—Examiners of the federal war labor board will conduct a hearing September 30 on the petition of the trainmen of the Interurban Lines of the Portland Railway, Light & Power company for an increase in wages in keeping with the scale of wages of other railroad men throughout the country. Approximately 100 men are affected. The examiners will hear arguments from the officials of the company who will be given opportunity to appear before the body. Conductors in the passenger service are asking for an increase from 48 1/2 cents an hour to 79 cents; motormen, from 48 1/2 to 73 cents; day freight conductors, from 50 to 71 1/2 cents; night freight conductors, from 56 to 70 cents; day brakemen, from 42 1/2 cents to 54 1/2 cents, and night brakemen, from 46 to 63 cents.
In addition, the men desire the eight-hour law to prevail and ask for time and one-half for overtime.

HUNGARIAN MUTINY PUT DOWN BY HUNS WITH MACHINE GUNS

LONDON, Sept. 19.—Two Hungarian regiments mutinied at Budapest and were shot down by German soldiers with machine guns, according to a Hungarian officer who has just been captured by the Americans on the western front, said a dispatch received here today.
