JOHN H. LEWIS HAS RESIGNED POSITION AS STATE ENGINEER

SALEM, Or., Nov. 21.—John H. Lewis, who has been state engineer for Oregon since May, 1905, submitted his resignation to Governor Withycombe yesterday, to be effective immediately. Mr. Lewis has accepted a position as chief engineer and manager for the new Warm Springs Irrigation district in Malheur county, and will leave today with his family for Vale, where he will have his offices. Vale lies in the center of the project. Governor Withycombe today announced the appointment of Percy A. Cupper, assistant state engineer, to serve four years. Mr. Cupper, in the election of November 5, was elected superintendent of water division No. 1, the Western district, and will combine the two offices, waiving the \$2400 salary allowed by the state for the water superintendent and receiving only the \$3000 salary of the state engineer. This is pursuant to a proposal made by Mr. Cupper several months ago when it first became known that Mr. Lewis contemplated resigning his office.
