OREGON LAWMAKERS WORK AS REVIEWED

Second Week is Exciting and Numerous Bills Are Introduced.

Salem, Ore.—The most exciting event during the second week of the legislative session was the political rumpus in the Senate over the Kellar resolution to have the Legislature endorse the Oregon system "as the best in the world."

ATTACKS LORIMER. Senator Cummins Asserts No One Could Contend Otherwise.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 27.—Senator Cummins, of Iowa, resuming his arguments against the adoption of the committee resolution exonerating Senator Lorimer, of Illinois, of the charge of having procured his seat by corrupt means, declared today that there were many circumstances to sustain the charges.

The Iowa Senator asserted it would have been impossible for the human mind to have fabricated such a story as that supplied to the Chicago Tribune by Representative White, of the Illinois Legislature, without having it refuted by the facts.
