## PORTLAND WOMEN AMONG THE SAVED

FRANK M. WARREN, SR., AND HERMAN KLABER THOUGHT TO HAVE PERISHED

## FATE OF I. COFFMAN IS IN DOUBT

Telegrams From New York Announce That Mrs. Warren is Safe—Son And Daughter Go East

PORTLAND, April 16.—(Special).—A few rifts of welcome tidings have penetrated the vast pall of gloom that had settled over a number of Portland families when the full purport of Sunday night had burst upon them at the news of the Titanic's destruction.

It is almost certain that all of the Portland passengers on board the liner, with the exception of Frank M. Warren, Sr., and Herman Klaber, are among the survivors now on board the rescue ship, Carpathia. The other local people, all of them women and children, have been heard from indirectly as among those saved.
