POULTRY—(Buying)—Hens 11c; spring 17c; and rooster 8c. HAY—(Buying), Clover at \$9 and \$10; oat hay, best \$10; mixed \$9 to \$12.

Butter, Poultry, Eggs. BUTTER—(Buying), Ordinary country butter 25c and 30c; fancy dairy 60c; eggs 25c and 30c.

VEGETABLES. ONIONS 1c lb; peppers 7c lb; tomatoes 40c to 50c; corn 8c and 10c doz.
