William H. Mann William Hodges Mann, governor of Virginia, was born in Williamsburg. Va., July 39, 1843. His education was received in an academy at Brownsburg, Va. His first public office was that of deputy clerk of Nottoway county, to which he was appointed in 1859. At the beginning of the Civil War he resigned his position and enenlisted as a private in a Virginia regiment of infantry. Soon after, however he was obliged to retire scout in the operations around Peters-burg. When peace had been declared he took up the study of law and in 1867 was admitted to the bar. Three years later he was elected county judge of Nottoway county. His service on the bench laster twenty-two years. In 1899 he was sent to the Virginia senate and in 1910 he was elected governor of the state on the democratic ticket.
