## S. P. WILL RUN NEW **ELECTRIC LINE SOON**

PORTLAND, Ore., Oct. 21.-According to oficial announcement given out today at the office of Robert E. Strahorn, president of the Portland, Eugene & Eastern Railway company, the Southern Pacific, parent company will after November I handle all op erating and traffic matters connected with the new electric system until actual electrification has taken place.

Along with this announcement Mr Strahorn made public the appointment of the operating and traffic officials of the Southern Pacific, whose duties are thus officially made to cover the P., E. & E. lines. D. W. Campbell is designated as general superintendent: F. L. Burchhalter, chief engineer; H. A. Hinshaw, general freight agent, and John M. Scott, general passenger agent. With the exception chief engineer, Burckhalter who is district engineer of the Southern Pacific, supplants R. T. Guppy, who has resigned to take a position on the Southern Pacific's staff in California.
