New York World: The Dutch government consented to the division of the Povie estate in The Hague valued at \$14,000,000, among nine heirs who live in America. Five of the heirs live in Brooklyn, two in the borough of Queens and the other two in the West. The heirs are gathering in New York, and they expect that the property will be handed over to them in a few weeks.

The settlement of the estate is the outcome of a contest inaugurated by the American heirs about twenty years ago. The Dutch govconment was at first adverse to handing the money over to the American heirs, but they proved their case.
