An attempt was made a few years ago to clean out Muddy, by pulling out the brush and cutting off what could not be pulled out, but on account of the density of the young growth and the crookedness of the stream the project was a failure.

It is now proposed to do the work in a business like manner. by straightening the stream and cutting a new channel where nec- P. essary.

This is a much needed improvement as Muddy drains much of the southern part of the county; and as it is now, it does not begin to to carry off the surplus water. Therefore many acres of land adjacent to the stream are swampy and fit only for summer pasture, To thoroughly drain this land

will restore it to new life and will increase its value many fold and much of the now waste land can then be cultivated.
