Trial: Roden accused of 'intentional maiming or torture' of the toddler

Lake Oswego, is charged with murder by abuse from neglect and maltreatment, first-degree manslaughter and six counts of criminal mistreatment.

An autopsy found Wing's daughter, Evangelina Wing, was the victim of homicide and apparently died from blunt force trauma. She would have turned 3 on Jan. 22.

Wing's two sons, ages 5 and 2, were found injured the same day Evangelina Wing was found dead. The boys were hospitalized and have been placed in state protective custody.

Wing's criminal mistreatment charges stem from her leaving the three children with Roden and withholding medical attention.

Deputy District Attorney Ron Brown said the grand jury has been extended in

Wing's case to allow further investigation into the time before she met Roden. The result of the extended grand jury could mean more charges against Wing, Brown said.

So far, Wing's charges do not rise to the level of the death penalty. However,

Roden is facing a slew of aggravated murder charges that qualify for the possibility of the death penalty.

Roden is charged with four counts of aggravated murder, two counts of murder by abuse, felony murder, first-degree unlawful sexual penetration, first degree

sex abuse, three counts of first-degree assault and three counts of criminal mistreatment. The sex abuse charges relate to Roden allegedly subjecting Evangelina Wing

to sexual contact by touching.

The charges against Roden accuse him of "intentional maiming or torture" of the toddler and having a "pat-

tern and practice of assault," since Oct. 31.

Court records show Roden, a former Georgia resident, was released from prison in January 2014 after being sentenced to 18 months for coercion related to a domestic violence case against another woman. He faced 52 counts of domestic violence and sex abuse in that case, which were dropped as part of his plea deal.

Wing and Roden each pleaded not guilty at a hearing Jan. 2. They are being held in Clatsop County Jail without the possibility of bail.

They are due back in court at 9 a.m. May 13 for a bail hearing, where the court will decide if they should continue without bail.

The hearing is the last one scheduled before the April 2016 trial.
