Yacht club readies for sailboat season

Astoria Yacht Club has announced its schedule for sailboat racing on the Columbia River for spring, summer and fall. Races are scheduled to start at 6:30 on Tuesday evenings from May through September, and early afternoon on special weekends throughout the season. Races are open to all keelboats, and scoring is based on the PHRF rating system, which awards handicaps based on boat measurements and equipment. Although there is keen competition among the local Olson 30 fleet, other designs are just as competitive and always welcome to participate.

The season is divided into Spring, Summer and Fall series
Spring Series: May 5, 12, 19, 26, June 2
Summer Series: June 23, 30, July 7, 14, 21
Fall Series: Aug. 11, 18, 25, Sept. 1, 8
 In addition, there will be two special series occurring in the two off weeks between each series:

Pursuit Races: June 9, July 28, Sept. 15. Each boat is assigned its own start time based on its PHRF rating.

Double-Handed Series: June 16, Aug. 4, Sept. 22. Crew limited to two per boat.

Because many who enjoy sailing and competition may not be prepared to participate on a weekly basis, the club is sponsoring four weekend regattas:

- Opening Day:** May 2
- Malcolm Boyle Memorial Cup:** July 11
- Astoria Regatta:** Aug. 8 and 9
- Closing Day:** Sept. 26

An organizational meeting for captains and prospective crew members will be held at the Astoria Yacht Club clubroom at 300 Industry St., Suite 201 overlooking the west boat basin at 6:30

p.m. April 7. Anyone wishing more information, or who would like to crew on a race boat should attend.

For those who would like to learn more about sailing on the Columbia, Astoria Yacht Club is hosting a free two-evening short course from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. on Tuesdays, April 14 and 21.

If you're curious about how a sailboat moves through the water and is able to sail against the wind, and have a desire to crew on a racing sailboat, plan to attend the "Fundamentals of Sailing for Racing Crew" course at the clubroom at the Port's West End Mooring Basin. No certifications of any kind are offered, nor will it satisfy the State of Oregon requirements for boater safety training, but this basic introduction to the active sport of sailing and learning together will lead to having more fun on the water as a member of a sailboat racing crew.

Interactive discussion will be facilitated by Jack Conner and Norm Shatto along with other AYC sailboat skippers. Discussion topics will include sailboat handling, safety on the water, terminology and gear, hydrodynamics, boat balance, sail theory and trim, teamwork and an overview of sailboat racing. Opportunities for applying the concepts learned during the class discussions may be put to use on the water with participating AYC skippers at arranged dates and times.

An official captain's sign-up meeting, which will cover the Rules of Racing, will be at 6:30 p.m. April 28 at the Yacht Club clubroom.

Sailboat racing is exciting and can be physically demanding, but as a team sport it does not require unusual athletic ability. More important is mental concentration and teamwork. It is a sport that is well suited to family participation, and the camaraderie and spirit of sportsmanship is promoted by after-race social gatherings at the clubroom. HILLSBORO — Astoria and Glencoe had to go 10 innings before deciding a winner Wednesday, on Day 3 of the Glencoe Tournament at Hillsboro Stadium.

In a game that featured seven lead changes, the Fishermen scored a run in the 10th inning for a 6-5 win.

Carter Wallace collected two RBIs on three hits for the Fishermen, with a triple in the second inning and singles in the first and sixth.

Kai Brown got the win on the mound, as he tossed shutout ball for 2 2/3 innings, finishing with four strikeouts and a walk, with two hits allowed.

Ryan Palek pitched the final inning and recorded the last three outs for the save.

Fritz Fremstad scored the game-winning run for Astoria, which plays at Rainier Tuesday.

HEPPNER — After a rough start to their road trip, the Knappa softball team won the second and third games in a row Wednesday, with a 3-1 win over Echo/Stanford and a 12-0 victory over Heppner.

Fishermen open golf season

STANWOOD, Wash. — The Astoria boys golf team opened the season Tuesday at Kayak Point Golf Course in Stanwood, Wash., where Stanwood High School scored a 313-459 win over the Fishermen.

Individually, Stanwood's Quinton Borseth was medalist with a 72, one stroke ahead of teammate Gagush Matsumoto.

Astoria was led by sophomore Arthur Clark (50-56—106), followed by sophomore Kirk Fausett (59-56—115), sophomore Ron Schumacher (61-58—119), sophomore Sydney Morris (61-58—119) and freshman Tim Schumacher (58-62—120).

"We had a lot of fun on our two-day spring break trip to the

Seattle area," said Astoria coach Dan Foss. "We played West Seattle Golf Course on Monday, and then had our match with Stanwood on Tuesday. This is the first time we've ever incorporated an actual match into our annual spring excursions. Stanwood is a very good team and this was their home course; they played well.

"We had a very young and relatively inexperienced varsity squad out on Tuesday — it was the first-ever event for three of my players, and the three seniors were not in the varsity lineup."

Clark nearly had a hole-in-one on the 145-yard, par 3, third hole, sending his tee shot to within 20 inches of the cup.
