According to The Harbor, one in six boys and one in four girls experience a sexual assault before the age 18. In addition, one in five women and one in 71 men will be raped at some point in their lives.

After the "nest emptied," Maryon began a career as a home economics teacher at Seaside High School, where she spent 17 of her happiest years devising new classes and truly enjoying her students, who remember her fondly to

ebrating Oregon's bounty. Maryon was a member of Calvary Episcopal Church and Saint Anne's Guild in Seaside for almost 70 years. She worked with the League of Woman's Voters, was a Cub Scout den mother and was on the board of directors of the Seaside Library. She also volunteered with United Way, SMART and, with Harrison, Meals on Wheels. Maryon was

a longtime member of the Astoria Country Club, where she enjoyed occasional golf, bridge and especially lunching with a group of friends nicknamed "The Desserters.'

Maryon Greenough was preceded in death by her husband Harrison, and her eldest son William. She is survived by her daughter Mary and husband Jack Kerwin, son Thomas and wife Donna, and grandchildren Jennifer, Nathan, Nicholas and Sue, great-grandchildren Alejandro, Mateo and Sean, and great-niece Joey.


