

Estacada Rangers top the Gulls in 10-4 win

SEASIDE — Estacada pitcher Lane Sittner scattered six hits with six strikeouts and two walks Tuesday afternoon, to lead the Rangers to a 10-4 nonleague baseball win over Seaside under sunny skies at Broadway Field.

Sittner had all the offensive support he would need from Levi Albrecht, who had a bases-loaded triple in the second inning and finished with four RBIs to lead Estacada.

The Rangers improved to 8-0, while the Gulls fall to 0-7.

Albrecht's triple down the right field line gave Estacada a 7-0 lead in the top of the second before Seaside answered with three runs in the bottom of the second.

Jacob Bassett and Dylan Wallis had back-to-back one-out singles, with Bassett sprinting home on a wild pitch for Seaside's first run.

Wallis scored on a single to right by Dawson Blanchard, and Otto Hoekstre came in on a fielder's choice out by Noah Brien.

The Rangers picked up additional runs in the third, fifth and sixth innings, while the Gulls scored their final run in the bottom of the sixth when Wallis plated Zach Quicke with a single to center.

Three Seaside pitchers allowed seven hits, with eight walks. Both teams turned 4-6-3 double plays late in the game.

Wallis had a pair of hits

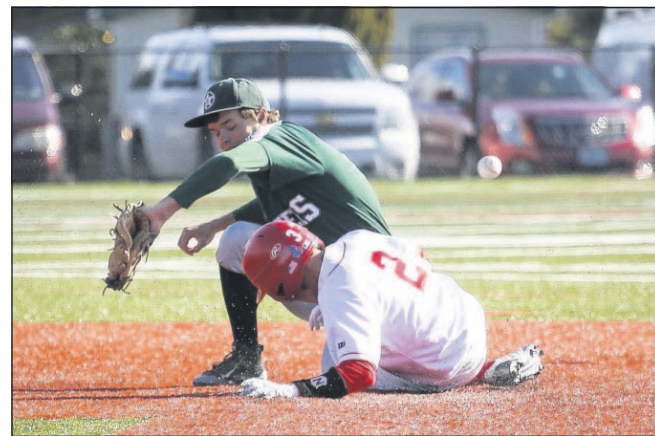
