Sticky Problem



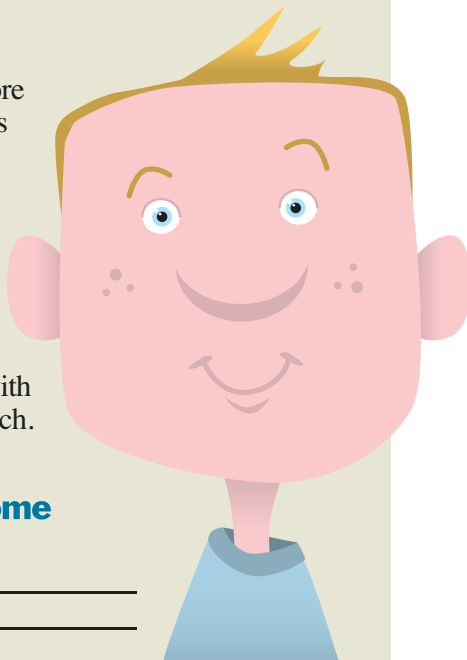
Evan collects stickers from the grocery store vending machine. Each costs 50¢. He buys one each time his family shops, which is usually three times a week.

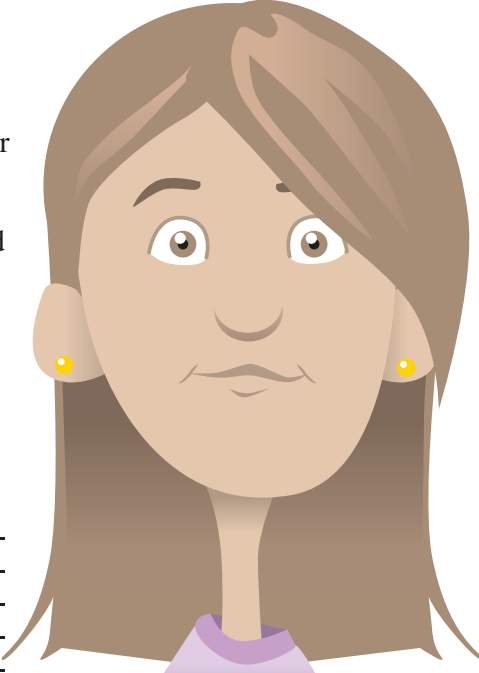
Bike Lane Pain
