TILLAMOOK — The Seaside boys golf team finished off another undefeated league season Wednesday, with a 327-376 win over Tillamook at Alderbrook Golf Course.

Sam Hinton and Shane Fritter led the Gulls with a pair of 78s. Aaron Richardson was a stroke back at 79 and Trenten Meyer shot 92 to round out the scoring for Seaside. Kevin Lacoste shot 97 as Seaside's fifth player.

Tillamook freshman Carter Lee led all players, shooting 75 for medalist honors on his home course.

"We got three guys in the 70s to help us put up a decent number today," Seaside coach Jim Poetsch said. "It was a step back from our performance on Monday, but good enough to take care of today's business. While we have a ton of talent, we did not do a very good job of course management today. On three holes where there is really no reward for being aggressive, we were too aggressive and gave away 18 strokes while earning only a single birdie. If we play smarter on those three holes, we are in the low 300s."

The next action for the Gulls will be Monday at the Cowapa League district tournament, at Quail Valley.

KNAPPA — Knappa scored 13 runs in the top of the fourth inning Wednesday, to highlight a five-inning, 19-2 Northwest League baseball win over Vernonia.

Jason Miller helped lead Knappa's offensive attack with a double, four RBIs and three runs scored.

Justin Dragoo was 3-for-3 with a home run and four RBIs; Noah Kinney also drove in four runs; and Austin Dragoo added a triple and three runs scored.

Knappa had just eight hits, but took advantage of eight walks and six hit batters.

Dale Takalo picked up the win on the mound, allowing five hits with eight strikeouts and two walks.
