- Statewide Community Based Volunteer Program, active in three or more regions.
- AmeriCorps Alumni, for volunteers after they have completed a year of service.

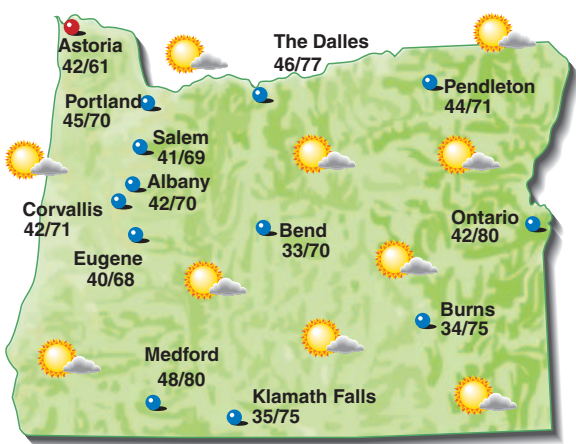

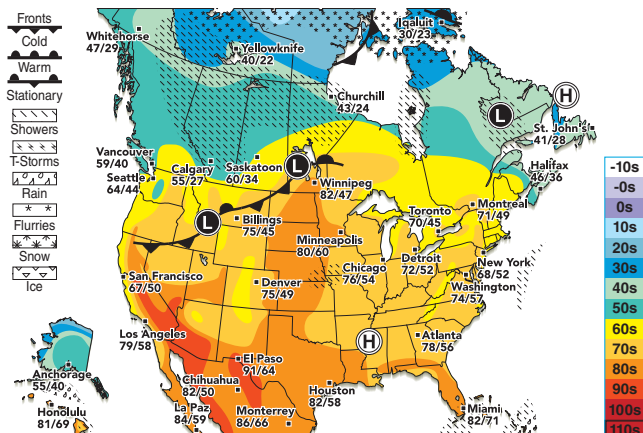
