Programs of Astoria Sunday Market

While the seasonal Sunday market is the engine that drives the mission and ensures sustainability, Astoria Sunday Market is involved in creating other projects that benefit the community. Other Market programs include:

Young Entrepreneur's Club and Market Biz Kidz

This is a collaborative project with Clatsop County 4-H to encourage young people to become entrepreneurs. The program has been sponsored by Recology Western Oregon since its launch in 2009. Wauna Federal Credit Union is also returning for its fourth year to sponsor this program and Clatsop Community Bank has been a long-time supporter of our Biz Kidz.

Cruise Ship Markets

Astoria Sunday Market provides vendors at the Port of Astoria creating a festive welcoming for the Cruise Ships. The Cruise Ship Hosts – a non-profit organization that provides over 200 volunteers to welcome Cruise guests to our city – take the lead in this effort and work closely with the Market and the Port of Astoria.
