Track: *Gulls speed to win 1,600-meter relay*

"The Astoria girls ... Kaylee was just awesome," Kilday said. "It was fun to see. I think we'll see Darian and Danielle (Willyard) vie a few more times.'

The Seaside girls scored three victories of their own, as senior Allison Kilday ran 15.84 to win the 100-meter hurdles, and broke her own school record with a 45.66 in the 300-meter hurdles. She is ranked in the top two in the state in both events.

The day ended with Seaside's senior foursome of Kelly Willyard, Elizabeth Barnes, Danielle Willyard and Kilday winning the 1,600-meter relay in 4:08.11 (second in state), with Astoria second.

Other state qualifiers for the Gulls were Blakesley (second, 1,500); Josie Smith (second, 3,000 meters); Bridgette Malone (second behind Kilday in the 300 hurdles); the 400 relay; and Danielle Willyard will end her prep career not far from where she will attend college (Northwest Christian), with second-place finishes in the long jump and triple jump.

On the boys' side, the Gulls won five events and placed second in two more.

Juneau Meyer blazed to a 51.23 win the 400 meters, and Jackson Januik ran 1:59.75 in the 800 to finish first ahead of Astoria's only state qualifier, Lucas Caruana (2:00.38).

Also on the track, William Garvin made it a clean Seaside sweep in the hurdles with a 15.65 in the 110s, and a 41.19 in the 300 hurdles.

Seaside's field event qualifiers were Josh Chesnut — who won the long jump with a leap of 20-7 $\frac{1}{2}$ —




