# Finger-picking guitar comes to Long Beach

LONG BEACH, WASH. — Finger-style Guitar Legend Terry Robb with Albert Reda perform at 7 p.m. Saturday, May 30 at Peninsula Performing Arts Center, 504 Pacific Ave. N., Long Beach, Washington. The doors open at 6:30 p.m. Beer, wine and other refreshments are available. Tickets are \$12 at the door.

Robb has long been considered one of the top acoustic blues guitarists. His dynamic, signature fingerpicking style and ability to sound like a hard, yet sophisticated, band in a solo performance have amazed audiences worldwide and earned him international acclaim.

A member of the Oregon Music Hall of Fame and Cascade Blues Association Hall of Fame, Robb is an icon of the vibrant Pacific Northwest music scene. A perennial Muddy Award winner, having won the Muddy Award for Best Acoustic Guitar an unprecedented 19 consecutive years since the category was introduced in 1992 until retiring from the competition in 2011, he is honored by the Cascade Blues Association with a namesake award: the "Terry Robb" Best Acoustic Guitar Muddy Award which is bestowed on a nominated guitarist from the Northwest region annually.
