"Every time I think about it I start crying," Phillips said. "I thought I was out of tears, but I keep crying.

"The outpouring was overwhelming to me and my husband," she added.

Now that she's stepped down as executive director, Phillips will be able to devote time to the Oregon Scholarship Foundation - she hopes to increase the amount of scholarships available from \$60,000 to more than a \$100,000 for contestants.

Miss Happy Valley Hailey Kilgore was crowned Miss Oregon's Outstanding Teen on Friday night.

The top five Miss Oregon Outstanding Teen girls included Miss Columbia River Olivia Colburn of Seaside.
