

Astoria scores 24 runs in win over Warriors

The Astoria Roundabout was at Aiken Field Tuesday afternoon, where the Astoria Ford Fishermen spent the day running around the bases in a 24-0 Junior State baseball win over Warrenton.

The Warriors walked 12 batters, hit two and committed four errors in the field to hurt their cause, while Astoria racked up 14 hits, five for extra bases.

Astoria senior-to-be Carter Wallace pitched four innings, allowing just three hits with six strikeouts and two walks.

Wallace did even more damage at the plate, where he

had a single, two doubles, a grand slam home run and six RBIs.

His bases-loaded homer in the third inning gave Astoria Ford a 13-0 lead through three innings.

Fridtjof Fremstad and Cade O'Brien both had two hits, including run-scoring doubles, and combined to drive in seven runs.

Astoria Ford's biggest inning was the fourth, when the Fishermen scored nine runs before the first out was recorded.

O'Brien and Kyle Strange both had two-run doubles in the inning, while Wallace had a pair of doubles.
