These vessels will help reduce the USCG's current Patrol Boat gap, allowing the USCG to better complete its various missions.

The EA identifies, describes, and evaluates potential environmental and socioeconomic impacts associated with potential homeporting of the FRCs and associated facility modifications at three alternative locations and a No Action Alternative. The EA also documents cumulative impacts from projects which are proposed, under construction, recently completed, or anticipated to be implemented in

The EA was prepared in accordance with the requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) (42 United States Code) Council on Environmental Quality Regulations for Implementing NEPA (40 Code of Federal Regulations §§1500- 1508) and associated CEQ guidelines; and Coast Guard Commandant Instruction (COMDTINST M16475.1D, National Environmental Policy Act Implementing Procedures and Policy for Considering Environmental Impacts. The EA serves as a concise public document that provides evidence and analysis for determining whether an Environmental Impact Statement or a FONSI is needed. The EA includes the purpose and need for the action, the proposed action and alternatives, a description of the affected environment, and an analysis of environmental

Based on the findings of the EA, the USCG concluded that the proposed action would have no significant impacts on the environment and issued the accompanying FONSI.
