I started in public service as a volunteer for several political and issues campaigns when I was in college in the 1960s and 70s, including the ERA amendment. In 1974 I moved to Clatsop County where I served on several local boards and commissions including the Union Health District (Seaside Hospital board), Clatsop Soil & Water Conservation District, HeadStart Policy Council, and I was the coordinator for the Necanicum Watershed Council for 6 years. In addition, I worked on Congressman AuCoin's Clatsop County campaigns for several terms as well as the campaigns for our local Democrats. Then in 1986 when a seat came up on the Clatsop County Commission I ran for and won it.

In 1986 the county changed its form of government to Home Rule and my commission seat became an unpaid position. I served for two years before going to Salem to work as Sen. Dukes' assistant which became the first of my 16 years as a Legislative Assistant to seven different legislators. In August of 2004 I was appointed to fill out the unexpired term of Rep. Elaine Hopson. I won the seat in the November 2004 election and have served for five terms representing House District 32 since 2004.

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
