Patrick Reiten is president and chief executive officer of PacifiCorp Transmission. He was appointed to this position in March 2015 and is responsible for managing the West's largest single owned-and-operated transmission system. He oversees transmission services, transmission planning and system operations as well as the company's transmission expansion projects.

Prior to his current position, Reiten served as president and CEO of Pacific Power, responsible for delivering electricity safely and reliably to 733,000 customers in Oregon, Washington and California. Pacific Power is a 105-year-old company serving 243 communities.

Reiten has actively maintained director or board leadership roles in community and industry interests. Currently, he serves as chair of Associated Oregon Industries and co-chair of The Freshwater Trust; he also serves on the Legacy Health System board of directors and the Oregon Business Council.

He earned a bachelor's degree in political science with an emphasis in economics from the University of Washington and completed executive training at the Wharton School of Business, University of Pennsylvania.
