

Preparing for a jolt

Crews train for earthquake response at Camp Rilea

WARRENTON — Search and rescue crews scrambled over concrete blocks, ducked into storage containers and climbed over smashed cars searching for victims.

At a nearby lake, a U.S. Coast Guard dive team conducted a water rescue operation. Volunteers carried people out of the woods on stretchers and helped them to a medical tent.

The victims were fake, but the lessons were real.

More than 200 first responders, military personnel, and volunteers descended upon Camp Rilea Armed Forces Training Center Tuesday and Wednesday

day for an earthquake response training exercise.

The Pathfinder Minutemen 2015 Exercise, now in its third year, is a multiagency, multistate operation designed to help plan a response to a major earthquake.

“What we’re doing here is bringing civilian, military, first responders, and volunteers together so that we can train together, understand each other’s lingo and acronyms,” Nick Choy, public affairs officer for Pathfinder Minutemen, said. “We all need to speak the same language, because when one of these things happens we are all going to have to work together.”

The exercise also allowed for people to make mistakes and learn from them.

“You want to have those hiccups and fits and starts now during an exercise like this,” Choy said. “You don’t want to go through those things during an actual earthquake response, that’s too late.”
