## Somers: County has had nine different managers in 15 years

In addition, he helped complete the transfer of the onsite septic system inspection program to the county's oversight.

Somers plans to stay busy as he finishes out his final weeks in Clatsop County.

"There is lots to do. The business of the county continues," he said. "I'm sure you will be hearing more about what the board is going to do in terms of its recruitment process."

### Selection process

The Board of Commissioners will determine a process for selecting a new county manager.

Board Chairman Scott Lee said the first step will be finding an interim county manager either internally or externally during the search for a permanent replacement.

The county will likely choose a recruiter to complete a national search. The Board of Commissioners briefly discussed the matter at its regular meeting Wednesday night, and it plans to talk more in-depth at its next meeting Aug. 26.

"I'm sorry to lose Scott. He has been a very capable manager and has helped the

county get through a very difficult financial period," Lee said. "He brought stability to the budget and has done a great job through a difficult financial crisis. We had to make a lot of tough decisions, but

keeping the financial health of the county was our first priority."

Clatsop County has had nine different county managers in 15 years.

An independent review

of Clatsop County management released in July found the county is operating effectively under Somers, but also concluded that tension and confusion among county workers could have been

avoided had management and benefit changes been better explained.

Earlier this year, Somers was a finalist for city manager of Mill Creek, Wash., north of Seattle.
